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## **The Role of a Volunteer Mentor**

**There is no need to travel.** Project MORE is a remote tutoring option.

A volunteer mentor simply opens a few links on their computer. The student and the volunteer see the same lesson materials on their screens. Mentor and student converse through their computer microphone or by phone.

**The mentoring sessions are very easy!** Mentors are trained by participating in an on-line session that demonstrates how to access and use each of the lesson components.
